

# HOGSBACK HERITAGE PROJECT

## *“OF THIS PLACE”*

THE HOGSBACK HERITAGE PROJECT WAS CONCEIVED AS AN ONGOING GATHERING, MEETING FOUR TO FIVE TIMES A YEAR, TO PROVIDE A FORUM FOR CREATIVITY AND LEARNING FOR GROUP PROJECTS AND INDIVIDUAL WRITING ABOUT THE HERITAGE OF THIS PLACE.

THE PROJECT IS DESIGNED TO COMPLIMENT THE BOULDER HERITAGE FESTIVAL HELD EACH JULY AND COMPLETED PROJECTS WILL BE HIGHLIGHTED AT THE FESTIVAL. THE 2010 FESTIVAL'S THEME IS “THE WOMEN.” THE GOAL IS TO FOCUS ON THE MANY FACETS OF THE WOMEN OF BOULDER, PAST AND PRESENT, AND TO CREATE A MULTI-GENRE PUBLICATION THAT PROVIDES INFORMATION AND INSIGHT AS WELL AS AN OPPORTUNITY FOR PARTICIPANTS TO SHARE YOUR WORK.

THIS PROJECT BEGINS AS PART OF THE **CLIFF NOTES CREATIVE WRITING WORKSHOP ON OCTOBER 16-18, 2009**. MEETING TIMES ARE FROM 10AM-12PM ON FRIDAY AND 8AM -10PM ON SATURDAY AND SUNDAY. THERE WILL BE FOLLOW-UP ACTIVITIES IN NOVEMBER, FEBRUARY, MARCH, MAY, AND JULY. THE COST TO PARTICIPATE IN THE OCTOBER HOGSBACK HERITAGE PROJECT IS \$50.00 FOR ADULTS, \$30.00 FOR STUDENTS. ADULTS MAY CHOOSE TO PARTICIPATE IN THE BOTH THE HOGSBACK HERITAGE PROJECT AND THE CLIFF NOTES CREATIVE WRITING WORKSHOP FOR \$150
